


Winners of 'DIMO Wishwasaya Wasiya' Rewarded with **Prizes Worth Over Rs.10 Million**



The progress review meeting of Sri Lanka's first-ever grid-tied microgrid pilot project was held recently at the University of Moratuwa with the participation of the Asian Development Bank (ADB). Country Director Mr Chen Chen, Chief of Energy Sector Group of ADB, Dr Priyantha Wijayatunga, General Manager- Lanka Electricity Company Pvt Ltd, Dr Narendra De Silva and other distinguished delegates from ADB, LECO & DIMO.

The Microgrid project progress achieved by Project teams of DIMO and Principle DHYBRID Power Systems GmBH was observed during this meeting.

This project was commenced in February 2021 and is currently installed with a 630kVA transformer, 30QLW of Solar PV



and 770kVA Backup Diesel generator feeding the microgrid. By completing the 400kW Battery Storage System in 2022, the microgrid system shall be running in an optimized fashion, managing multiple energy sources, ultimately saving the power generation cost.

With the successful completion of the project, the DIMO power engineering team, together with the principal DHYBRID is very confident in providing clean energybased uninterrupted p ower supply solutions to take the country forward.




