Simultaneously, the company bridges regional gaps through projects such as the Kilinochchi Water Supply Scheme. Utilising pioneering dissolved air flocculation technology, this installation treats and delivers clean water to thousands of northern households daily. The Jaffna Kilinochchi Water Supply and Sanitation Project stands as a monumental engineering endeavour designed to meet urgent national priorities in utility modernisation.

In the sphere of public health, DIMO Healthcare continually strengthens local medical frameworks by introducing advanced global technologies to public teaching hospitals.

A recent milestone includes the installation of the sophisticated Artis Zee Floor Digital Subtraction Angiography (DSA) system by Siemens Healthineers at the Colombo South Teaching Hospital (CSTH) in Kalubowila. This cutting-edge technology gives interventional radiologists exceptional, real-time imaging to perform complex, minimally invasive vascular procedures.

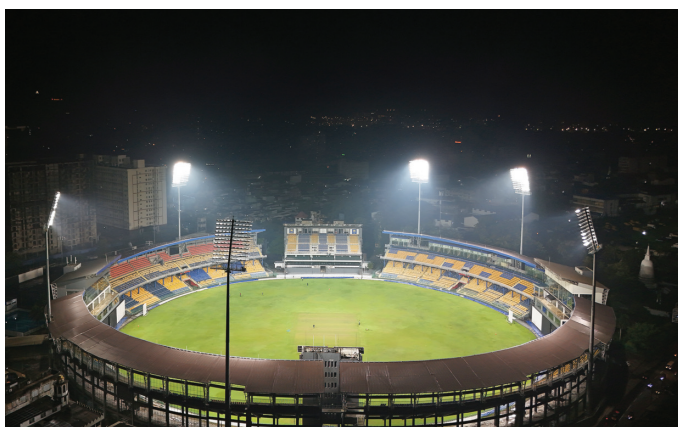
By embedding these elite systems into public healthcare spaces, DIMO ensures that everyday citizens receive the lifesaving medical care they deserve.

DIMO's impact on human wellbeing also reaches out into the environment and community lifestyle spaces. As Sri Lanka transitions toward a greener future and global parameters shift towards sustainability, nation building requires clean energy integration.

A landmark achievement in DIMO's renewable portfolio is the solar power project in Galle, comprising four solar power plants with a total installed capacity of 18 MW. This investment contributes over 33.6 million kWh of renewable electricity annually to Sri Lanka's national grid while reducing carbon emissions by approximately 12,945 tonnes each year.

In addition to the above, the 5MW solar power plant in Anuradhapura generates over 9.4 million kWh annually to power rural homes across the region.

Meanwhile, DIMO enriches the nation's vibrant sports culture. The company pioneered sustainable sports engineering by installing Sri Lanka's first ever LED lighting system at the Rangiri Dambulla International Cricket Stadium and followed this by modernising the iconic R. Premadasa International Cricket Stadium with a state-of-the-art LED floodlighting system.



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These advancements reduce energy consumption while allowing families and fans across the country to share in the unity and excitement of world-class sporting events.

Even the simple act of commuting to work or travelling home is quietly supported by DIMO. The railway network is the daily lifeline for hundreds of thousands of Sri Lankans. To prevent disruptions, DIMO works around the clock to support Sri Lanka Railway's (SLR) MTU engine fitted locomotive operations with prompt technical service and genuine parts.
